JOB TITLE: Ride Operator

REPORTS TO: Carousel Supervisor

DEPARTMENT: Operations

JOB SUMMARY: Ride Operators are responsible for operating and attending rides for adults and/or children, reading and speaking ride safety instructions, enforcing height requirements and maintaining ride capacity logs.

SPECIFIC DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Greet and provide Guests with courteous service. Assist Guests as needed with questions, comments and concerns. Inform Guests of and enforce ride safety requirements and policies.
- Operate rides as trained and as according to Standard Operating Procedures manuals.
- Maintain constant focus and attention on Guests and rides while in operation.
- Maintain ride cleanliness.
- Other duties as assigned and required based on the needs of the operation.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must possess oral and written English skills and be able to read and understand operations manuals.
- Must be able to communicate with Guests and other employees effectively.
- May be exposed to bodily fluids and will utilize chemicals and cleaning agents daily.
- Required to work in various weather conditions.
- Candidate must be 16 years of age or older.
- Available to work overtime. – If over 18 years of age.
- Available to work flexible hours including evenings, weekends and holidays.
- All job offers contingent on passing a criminal, drug, and social security background check.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS: The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

- Requires ability to stand and walk eight to ten hours for the shift.
- Requires constant kneeling, bending, reaching above shoulder, pushing and pulling.
- Requires constant lifts and carries up to 30 pounds.
- Requires manual and bi-manual dexterity, fine and gross motor skills, eye/hand coordination, near vision, hearing and speech.
- Possess 20/20 corrected vision. (Corrective lens, if required, must be worn while on duty).
- Possess normal or average corrected hearing. (Defined as 25 decibels or better in the frequency range of 500HZ-4000HZ considered normal speech frequency range). (If a corrective device is needed to achieve this range, it must be worn while on duty.)
